As we waited for the First Thunder of the season, I was grateful to speak with Wilfred "The Star Guy" Buck, from Opaskwayak Cree Nation and Siksika Astrophysicist Rob Cardinal about the science and stories of the recent Solar Eclipse, the reverence and silence within the darkness of totality, the connection between the alignment, states of matter, and ceremonies, protocols of NOT LOOKING at these significant cosmic events, the Creation of "Tipis and Telescopes," the three-body problem, the North Star and moon cycles, and the origin of the Thunderbirds.

Eclipse & Ceremony

- alignment of: lodge-alter-fire (see image in video episode) (Buck)
- alignment of: sun-moon-earth
- protocols of the eclipse, how different they are between nations
- respect and humility
- this is a time when the sun and moon are “coupling” (Cardinal)
- how strange it is that the Sun and the Moon appear as the same size from Earth?! (Cardinal)
- please do not look at the sun!!

Information vs. Knowledge (Cardinal)

- information: disconnected
- knowledge: you have to dance with it

States of Matter

- when everything is active, like in a sweatlodge ceremony and in scientific cycles. All is related. (Buck)
- states of matter in a sweatlodge- constant changes in carbon and hydrogen (Buck)
- This is like the F-orbital (Cardinal)

Three Body Problem

- Earth-Moon-Sun and Euler ([Wiki](#))
- gravity between the three objects makes it very difficult to predict place or create stability (Cardinal)
- How did the moon get to where it is??

The North Star

- “The Heart of the Sky” (Buck)

- 26,000 yr cycle of the North Star (Cardinal). Now Polarius, next North Star is Vega. Indigenous people have known the cycles of the North Stars for thousands of years, passed on in their oral stories.
- 22,000 year ago, the North Star was Draco, it was in the Thunderbird constellation (Buck). We know this because of the stories that have been passed on.

Moon Cycles

- 13 cycles of the moon, each has a season within itself. (Buck)
- each moon cycle has a name connected to the community and land it is seen/experienced from.
- what is the Indigenous name for the June full moon from the lands you are listening to the podcast from?
- Moon cycles connect with Language (Cardinal). These moons and stories are so contextual, connect to specific communities, and carry so much information.

First Thunder

- there has to be SO many things (humidity, temperature, sunlight, latitude etc...) that come together at the same time and the right time, for the first thunder to happen (Cardinal). This is why so many Indigenous people have ceremonies and honour the first thunder of the season.
- this first thunder and flash of lightening call the bundles to open and dance.
- first thunder is about the FOUR ENERGIES (rock, oxygen, hydrogen)

Thunderbird and Sagittarius A*

- Thunderbird nest in Sagittarius A*. These stories have been shared about the significance of this location for thousands of years, but only recently have global scientists been recognizing this blackhole.
- interstellar weather is thunderbird territory (Cardinal)

Weather and the Cosmos

- weather is like a mood (Cardinal)
- chaos of trying to predict the weather (Buck)
- connection between weather, the moon, and sap (Buck)
